











































USS Missouri BB-63 Crewmember Spotlight



Seaman Billy Ray Lyerly

Billy Ray Lyerly enlisted in the Navy in 1950, whereupon he was sent to Great Lakes Recruit Training for his Basic Training. His Basic Training was cut short and during the start of his fourth week, the complete class of trainees were sent to the train station in Chicago to board trains for an unknown destination. They were accompanied by Shore Patrol and were given a bag of sandwiches to eat on the train. They arrived at their destination, the Norfolk Naval Station, for assignment to USS Missouri BB63. When the additional sailors arrived the ship was being maintained by a skeleton crew and midshipmen. The ship added 952 enlisted men and 36 officers to bring the total number of ships personnel to 114 officers and 2070 crewmen. The ship got underway after 5 days of supply and ammunitions onload. The ship's next destination was the Panama Canal for transit to the Pacific, but as fate would have it, the ship ran into a Hurricane and sustained considerable damage to the equipment that was brought onboard. The Missouri had to spend 5 extra days in Hawaii making needed repairs and

add additional 20mm and 40mm guns for defense against aircraft. Exactly one month and one day after leaving the east coast, two hurricanes, naval gunfire support training and replacing two helicopters lost during the hurricanes, The Missouri arrived off Korea to take her place on the battle line.

Seaman Billy Lyerly was assigned to 3rd division and his General Quarters Station was a Ships anti-aircraft gun that was later mounted in the gun tub on Turret Two. They only manned this station when the Turrets were not firing. He has some amazing stories of his Korean War deployment. The shelling of the coast-line of North and South Korea, Inchon and Wonsan, General Douglas MacArthur's visit onboard the mighty Mo, the bitter cold of the 1950/1951 winter, Bob Hope's show on the fantail, the ship's stop in Japan and Pearl Harbor and Long Beach with arrival April 1951 back in Norfolk Va to a Large Homecoming Crowd.

Billy Ray Lyerly spent the second half of his Naval career as a Shore Patrolman in the port of Naples and one of the persons he met and befriended was none other than the Mafia Boss, Charles (Lucky) Luciano who operated a café in Naples.

After his service, Billy Ray attended East Carolina University, went to NC Highway Patrol School in Chapel Hill NC, met his wife Elizabeth Ann, got married in 1957, spent 12 years as a Patrolman and 18 years as a senior supervisor with the NC Department of Motor Vehicles in enforcement. He retired to

Dallas, NC, has two children, attends Antioch Lutheran Church and loves spending his time telling USS Missouri Battleship stories to everyone who will listen.






